

Awards for Excellence

Terms and Conditions

- The Awards for Excellence are administered by Master Painters Australia ACT Inc. All decisions relating to the awards will be made by the committee of Master Painters Australia ACT Inc. and are final and binding on all entrants.
- Contractors may nominate their own projects or projects may be nominated by third parties such as project owners, project managers or suppliers of painting and decorating materials.
- The 2014 awards are for projects completed from 1 July 2013 to 30 June 2014.
- Entries must be on a completed entry form and must be received by 31 July 2014. The entry must be accompanied by the prescribed entry fee. If the entry fee is not received by the closing date the entry will not be considered.
- Entrants must provide at least three photographs of their project. Digital photographs are preferred. If photographs are not supplied then the entry will not be considered. Photographs cannot be returned.
- All complying entries will be considered by the judges but not all projects will be physically inspected. Selection of projects to be inspected will be at the judges' discretion. Projects selected for inspection will be visited by a member or members of the judging panel. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence or communication will be entered into.
- Entrants must ensure that permission has been given by the property owner and any other relevant parties for the project to be entered into the awards, inspected by the judges and used for publications and publicity.
- All entries remain the property of Master Painters Australia ACT Inc and photographs supplied may be used in a variety of publications.
